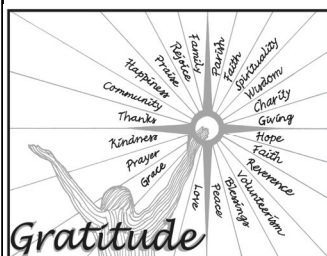

## Enter the Kingdom of Heaven

The parable in the Gospel reading is about entering the kingdom of heaven, as Jesus says when he explains it. In the parable, a father says to one of his sons, "Go to work in my vineyard, Son!", and that son says, "NO!" Then the father says to his other son, "Go to work in my vineyard, Son!" And that son says, "YES!" Which of these sons is the good one? Which of them pleases his father? Which one enters the Kingdom of Heaven?

You might answer that it is the son who says "YES" to his father. YES is the right answer to give to any command of God's, too. What could be worse than saying "NO!" to God? Who would think that those defiant and rebellious NO-sayers could be pleasing to God? And so it seems that the YES-sayers are the ones who will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. But this is not what Jesus says. He says that the NO-sayers are the ones who enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Why?

In the parable, the son who says "YES" to his father doesn't actually do what his father wants him to do. It's the son who says "NO!" to his father who actually does the father's will. The NO-sayers' words are contrary to God's will; their deeds are in accordance with it. It is just the other way around with the YES-sayers. The words of the YES-sayers are obedient to God's will, but their lives are lived in opposition to it. The words of the YES-sayers are empty. Their lives tell the real truth about them, not their words. The truth is that they reject God's will, however much acceptance there is in their words.

And so the Psalm gives us the right prayer to go with this parable: "Lord, teach us your ways!" Our ways need to be God's ways. It is our lives that need to say YES to God.

## Entrar en el Reino de los Cielos

La parábola del Evangelio trata de la entrada en el reino de los cielos, como el mismo Jesús lo explica. En la parábola, el padre le dice a uno de sus hijos, "hijo, vete hoy a trabajar en la viña», y él responde: "¡NO quiero!" Entonces el padre le dice a su otro hijo, "hijo, vete a trabajar en la viña" Y éste le responde: "¡SÍ señor!" ¿Cuál de los dos hijos actuó bien? ¿Cuál de ellos complació a su padre? ¿Cuál de los dos entrará en el Reino de los Cielos?

A estas preguntas podrías responder que el hijo que dijo "SI". Así mismo, SI, es la respuesta correcta a cualquier mandamiento de Dios. ¿Qué podría ser peor que decir "NO" a Dios? ¿Quién pensaría que aquellos desafiantes y rebeldes que dicen NO podrían ser agradables a Dios? Y, así, parece que los que dicen SI son los que entrarán en el Reino de los Cielos. Pero esto no es lo que dice Jesús. Él dice que los que dicen NO son los que entrarán en el Reino de los Cielos. ¿Por qué?

En la parábola, el hijo que dice "SI" en realidad no hace lo que su padre quiere que haga. Es el hijo que dice "NO" quien en realidad hace la voluntad del padre. Las palabras de quien dice NO son contrarias a la voluntad de Dios; pero sus obras están de acuerdo con dicha voluntad. Es exactamente al contrario con quien dice SI. Las palabras de quien dice SI están en concordancia con la voluntad de Dios, pero su vida está en oposición a esta voluntad. Las palabras de quien dice SI son palabras vacías. Su vida dice la verdad sobre él, no sus palabras. La verdad es que rechaza la voluntad de Dios, aunque con sus palabras dice aceptarla.

Y así, el Salmo nos ofrece la oración perfecta para esta parábola: "¡Señor, enséñanos tus caminos" Nuestros caminos deben ser los caminos de Dios. Es con nuestras vidas que tenemos que decir sí a Dios.

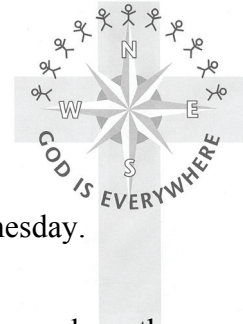
