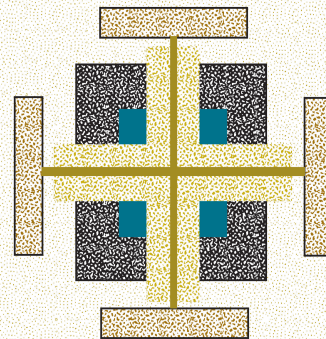

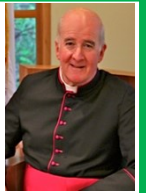

From the Pastor



Dear parishioners and friends in Christ,

The summer storm last weekend knocked out the power to the church and rectory. With no electricity for lights and air conditioning, we moved the 7:30 Sunday morning Mass to the lower church. Once again, the lower church has proven to be a very welcome resource. I am happy to report that the power has been restored and the electricity is back up.

The air conditioning in both our main church and the lower church is working well. While not everyone is comfortable with air conditioning, we must be considerate of the greater good of those in attendance. If you are uncomfortable, you can always bring along a light jacket or sweater. And thank you for your weekly generosity in our collections during Mass that provide for the increase in electricity and required maintenance of our A/C units.

With the summer break from school, we are nonetheless in the process of planning for a new "church year" of activities and programs, beginning in the fall. Religious Education grade level classes are now being formed. If your family has not registered for the fall term, please do so immediately to secure a place for your child. 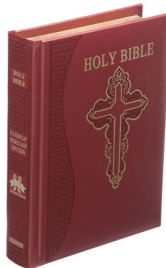
