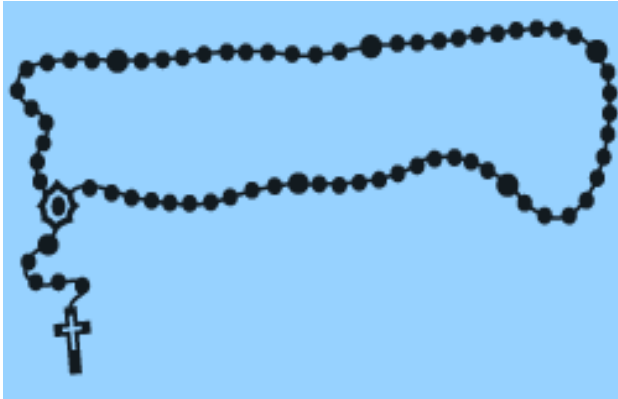




THE ROSARY

1. Start with the **Sign of the Cross**.
2. Then pray the **Apostles' Creed**.
3. Pray the **Our Father** at every large bead.
4. Pray the **Hail Mary** at every small bead.
5. Pray the **Glory Be to the Father** after each set of small beads.
6. Pray the **Hail Holy Queen** at the end of the Rosary.
